



2018 Seattle Camino de Santiago

On Saturday, March 24, 2018, the day before Palm Sunday, we will do our second annual mini- pilgrimage in Seattle based loosely on the Camino de Santiago in Spain. We'll begin with a free hot lunch in Crispin's Kitchen at St. John's, and then pray the first two Stations of the Cross in St. John's Church. We'll then walk and take Metro busses through six other Catholic churches, ending at St. James Cathedral, praying two Stations in each church. Since our ending point is our St. James Cathedral, we're borrowing the name from the famous Spanish pilgrimage, which has their St. James's Cathedral as its goal. We're calling our mini-pilgrimage the Seattle Camino de Santiago.

Everyone is invited to join us for all or any part of this small pilgrimage.

- 1:15 PM, Stations 3 and 4, Blessed Sacrament Church
- 2:05 PM, Stations 5 and 6, St. Patrick's Church
- 3:00 PM, Stations 7 and 8, St. Joseph's Church
- 3:45 PM, Stations 9 and 10, Immaculate Conception Church
- 4:20 PM, Stations 11 and 12, St. Ignatius' Chapel, Seattle University
- 4:50 PM, Stations 13 and 14, St. James Cathedral
