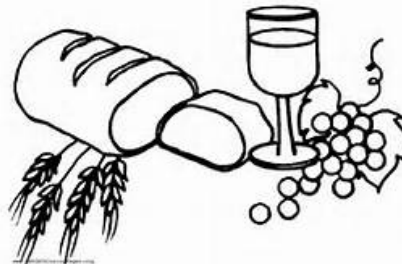
### COMMUNION
